

#### A Year in the Life of William Shakespeare: 1599 By James Shapiro

In 1599 Shakespeare and his colleagues opened their new theater, The Globe, and the Bard began to write soliloquies exposing the inner thoughts and feelings of his characters. Actor, Shakespearian teacher and fellow SIR Mark Jordan gave an opening summary of the events and political currents of the last years of Queen Elizabeth's reign and a discussion followed. While attendance was perhaps the best ever, the reviews were decidedly mixed, with some feeling the book too much of an academic exercise and others maintaining it provided a welcome entre into the history of the time and an enlightening exposition of Shakespeare's development. The average score was 3 stars. Lytton DeSilva recommended this book while engaging in the discussion were Richard Black, Cord Hull, Al Reynolds, John Riordan, Joel White, Jack Butler, Paul Freitas, Jerry Christopherson, Garrett Girvan, Dick Kauffman, Art Donaldson, Jim Scott, John Fraser and Bob Matthews.

The group will next meet on September 23 to discuss Freedom's Forge by Arthur Herman. Tentatively scheduled for the October 28 meeting is "This Town: Two Parties and a Funeral" by Mark Leibovich .

Did not attend one-half (5) of the regular luncheon meetings within the previous twelve consecutive month period. NOTE: Excused meetings cannot be included to achieve the minimum attendance.

RULE 101. Certification of attendance by a member at another Branch meeting will be considered as a credit to his attendance record. (Maximum of 2 visits per calendar year).

#### Non Responsibility Declaration

#### **Checks for Trips**

Trips of 2 days and 1 night or less may be made payable to the Branch conducting the trip. Trips in excess of 1 night must be made payable to the travel agency involved.
